## Recognition and naming

For question 4 & 5 you will need three items: comb, pannikin (cup) and matches. If the subject has poor vision, put each object in their hand and ask them to recognise it.

4. Hold up each item in turn and ask  
**"What do you call this?"**

5. Hold up each item in turn and ask  
**"What is this one for?"**

5.1 Comb	___ /1
5.2 Pannikin (cup)	___ /1
5.3 Matches	___ /1

Then hide each object in turn (omit this if poor vision, and name objects for them to remember)

Say, **"I'm going to put this one here, this one here....Now don't forget where I put them."**
